AGENDA: (1) Guest: Carol Gray, Julie Fincher, & Stefan Myers from Relay for Life.

It is a 24-hour walk. It takes place at the La Pine High School track. They would like to include Gilchrist, Crescent, Crescent Lake, Sunriver. 'Cure Cancer Olympics' is the Theme. Part of the money raised goes for gas cards & food for those affected with cancer, & their families.

The teams are usually 8-10 people per team. To be a sponsor, it starts at \$250. Team registration is \$100. Each member of the team raises \$100 if possible. It will be June 27-28th from 10 AM – 10 A.M. It will include lunch, dinner, & breakfast.

(2) Gilchrist Cruise/Summer Fun Day: Linda Barron

A lot of discussion went into this subject. It was to be sponsored by the North Klamath County Chamber of Commerce & the Central Oregon Old Car Club. **Unfortunately, it has been cancelled as of April 28th, 2009.**

(3) American Flags: Tina Miller

The last 2 fundraisers we've had was to be able to purchase flags for the towns of Gilchrist, Crescent, Crescent Lake and Chemult. Tina had some prices from two different sources, with the flags averaging around \$13.50 - \$15.50.

Deon Murray volunteered to do some inquiring with a company he has dealt with in the past, with a possibility of acquiring flags for \$5 each.

There was also discussion regarding sponsorship or a memorial plaque to go on the poles, and whether to have them laminated or in plaque form. Barbara Sullivan motioned to use laminate for the sponsorship/memorial at a donation of \$10.

(4) Flea Market Fundraiser: Tina Miller

June 20th has been set for this event. Tina said we will have room for 30+ tables, each 10x10. It will be \$25/per table or if a member of NKCCC - \$15/per table, each person supplies their own table. It will be advertised in the Frontier, WiseBuys, & on KITC.

(5) Membership Drive: Kristy Chancellor

At this time we have 20 Members in good standing. There are only 4-5 new members this year that will be receiving the membership certificate. We are not sending out certificates to members from last year.

Comments/other issues: Terri Anderson said that SB2227 passed by 1 vote and that SB430 has until June 30th. She said that Gilchrist – Crescent should not be affected because we had great representation show up and plead our cause.
