

North Klamath County Chamber of Commerce Minutes

January 15, 2008 - Visitor's Center/Gilchrist Mall

Called to Order at: 12:06 P.M. with Linda Barron, President, presiding

Members/Guests Present: Linda Barron, Tina Miller, Herb Romey, Judy Scally, Barbara Sullivan, Renee Kapp, Kathy Altman, Michael Feiler & Kristy Chancellor

Prior Minutes: Minutes approved; motion to approve by Tina Miller.

Treasurer's Report: Barb handed out a copy of the Treasurer's Report to everyone present. We did not go over the report, so we could get to our guest, Michael Feiler presenting a new web design.

AGENDA: Linda introduced our guest speaker:

(1) Guest Speaker Michael Feiler/Web Design

He showed a sample page and explained how he charges. The layout is \$30, he will do the maintenance. To add pics = \$.50/picture. It would be \$15 for each page, if there are 9 pages or more it would be \$10/page.

Linda Barron explained that the Chamber is under contract with Micah Ayers till June 2009. We could pay off the existing contract and go ahead with Michael Feiler now, or we could stay with our existing contract till June then make the change.

Barb motioned we pay off the existing contract with Micah Ayers and go with Michael Feiler; Kathy Altman seconded and all were in favor.

(2) Judy Scally: National Geographic/Geo Tourism & Oregon Scenic Bike Way

They have just formed committees and how it will affect us. We have to have a list individually of all sites to see. We need to start a list. Renee Kapp suggested we e-mail these to Linda. The map will be from Mt. Ranier to Crater Lake, I-5 in the west to Hwy.97 in the east.

Judy Scally reported that the Or.Scenic Bikeway Committee is to meet for the first time on January 21st. Renee Kapp volunteered to contact them to let them know we're here.

(3) Sweetheart Bingo Fundraiser/February 14th

Linda Barron suggested we do a cash and "white elephant gift" rather than request donations from local businesses.

Everyone opted to call this 'Valentine Day Bingo' instead of 'Sweetheart'.

We need a caller still.

Barbara Sullivan said she paid the dues for becoming a member of the Community Center, but not the \$75.00 for use of the Center on the 14th.

It was decided that we would have for the menu: Baked Potatoes with all the toppings to choose from. All Chamber officers are to bake Valentine Style cupcakes (any flavor) to bring. Linda Barron will notify Wise Buys & the Frontier and Judy will have Bill announce on KITC Radio. Kathy Altman said she could design the flyers.

(4) Chamber Application & Flyer for 2009

Linda Barron handed out the 2009 application for needed corrections? Discussion followed. Once corrections are made the applications will be sent out.

Linda Barron researched getting a special mailing rate, and it's not cost effective at this time, so we'll have to pay individually. We need to do a door-to-door membership drive. Linda Barron said she would look into how other chambers handle their membership drives.
